Development & Peace's Involvement in Haiti - Two emergency staff members are being sent to Haiti to join the Caritas relief mission already underway there. They will assist the team in providing immediate needs such as shelter, food and water, and will assess the situation in order to relay information to Canada and begin to form a response plan for the long reconstruction process that lies ahead. "Our partners on the ground are exhausted. Many of them have lost close ones and are dealing with this on a very personal level. We want to be there to lend a hand and begin the important task in laying the foundation for our work in assisting to rebuild lives, livelihoods and communities in the stricken country," said Michael Casey, Executive Director of Development and Peace. All donations made to D. & P. contribute to the supplies needed and the efforts of the staff, and the organization qualifies to have public donations matched by the Federal Government.
