**Parenting Tip of the Month** - Building a relationship with our children provides life time benefits for everyone. One element involved with this is teaching our children our family values; this means being specific about what is and what is not acceptable behaviour. In fact, a survey of 5,500 teenagers done by National Young Drivers Association showed that risky driving behaviour, including not wearing a seat belt, drinking and driving and cell phone use while driving was strongly associated with the way teens and parents communicate and approach rules about safety.
