Why do we offer Mass intentions?

Mass intentions are offered to God as prayers  
of intercession or thanksgiving. They may be for  
deceased family members and friends, or for special  
intentions for the living, such as a wedding anniversary  
or vocations to the priesthood. Even if the priest does not  
publicly state the Mass intention out loud, he knows  
which intention he is celebrating, and takes it very  
seriously. It is important to know that Masses cannot be  
bought or sold. However, there is a long-standing tradi-  
tion in the Catholic Church of giving Mass stipends (a  
free will offering) which is meant to symbolize my offering  
to God for that particular intention and support for my  
Parish.

*In order to make sure that ever person in the parish has  
a chance to request Mass intentions, there is a limit of  
five single intention Masses per person, per year. For  
multiple intention Masses (celebrated Wednesdays and  
Thursdays), you may request an unlimited number of  
intentions.*
