#### **MEMORIAL MASSES - Prayers for the Faithful Departed**

As we near the month of November, the Church invites us to take a moment to pray for our deceased family members and friends. In our parish, this will take place in a special way during the Memorial Masses and devotions for the deceased, celebrated throughout the week following All Saints' and All Souls' Weekend — from Monday, November 3rd to Friday, November 7th.

#### Each evening will follow the same format:

**6:30 p.m.** – We gather before the Blessed Sacrament to pray a decade of the Rosary together and to read aloud the names submitted in the remembrance envelopes. 7:00 p.m. - We celebrate a Requiem Mass, offering all our prayers for the faithful departed.

You are most welcome to bring a memorial candle or a small photo or item in memory of your loved one, which may be placed on the table prepared near the altar. When filling out your remembrance envelopes, you may indicate your preferred day (Monday, Tuesday, etc.). If no preference is noted, the names will be included throughout the week.
