

THE MONTH OF AUGUST

The Catholic Church dedicates the month of August to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The Immaculate Heart is often venerated together with the Sacred Heart of Jesus (the devotion we celebrate in June) and with good reason. Just as the Sacred Heart represents Christ's love for mankind.



There is no better example of the Christian life than that offered by Mary. We do not worship Mary or place her above Christ, but we come to Christ through Mary, as Christ came to us through her.

SOLEMNITY OF THE ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY - AUGUST 15

On Friday, August 15th, the Church celebrates the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, commemorating her being taken up into Heaven, body and soul. In Polish tradition, this day is also known as the Feast of Our Lady of the Herbs (Matki Boskiej Zielnej), highlighting Mary's connection to nature and her care for those who work the land.

On this day, the faithful bring bouquets of herbs, flowers, and grains to the church, where they are blessed by the priest. This custom is rooted in an ancient legend, which tells that when the apostles visited Mary's tomb after her death, they found not her body. but fragrant herbs and flowers. The blessed herbs symbolize God's blessings, health, abundance, and our gratitude for the gifts of the earth. It is a beautiful tradition that unites faith with respect for creation we encourage all parishioners to continue honoring it.

MASS INTENTIONS FOR 2026

Mass intentions for 2026 will be accepted beginning Tuesday, September 2nd. Please call or visit the parish office to book your intentions.

Why do we offer Mass intentions?

Mass intentions are offered to God as prayers of intercession or thanksgiving. They may be for deceased family members and friends, or for special intentions for the living, such as a wedding anniversary or vocations to the priesthood. Even if the priest does not publicly state the Mass intention out loud, he knows which intention he is celebrating, and takes it very seriously. It is important to know that Masses cannot be bought or sold. However, there is a long-standing tradition in the Catholic Church of giving Mass stipends (a free will offering) which is meant to symbolize my offering to God for that particular intention and support for my Parish.

In order to make sure that ever person in the parish has a chance to request Mass intentions, there is a limit of five single intention Masses per person, per year. For multiple intention Masses (celebrated Wednesdays and Thursdays), you may request an unlimited number of intentions.
