

FINANCE COMMITTEE REPORT FOR ST. GABRIEL'S PARISH 2023

Below is a summary of our financial results for the calendar year of 2023. We thank our parish Finance Committee for their hard work in preparing the budget, financial statements, and monitoring cash flow. Thank you to outgoing member Matthew McRae and welcome to new member Raffael Kapusty.

We are happy to report a surplus for the year-end of \$125.294 supported by an increase in attendance for Masses and generous donations to our building fund. Our income is up 21% over 2022, with expenses up 23% over 2022. A significant portion of our surplus will be put towards deferred maintenance items and building projects in 2024.

This year we added new staff in the form of our new associate priest Fr. Paul Niesobedzki and our new Sister Alice Jaszczak MChR as well as began many major projects in our parish. Below you will find a list of the major improvements in our parish as well as an income statement for the 2023 fiscal year:
