PENTECOST SUNDAY

This weekend, the Church celebrates Pentecost, one of the most important feast days of the year that concludes the Easter season.

What is Pentecost?

On the Feast of Pentecost, Christians commemorate the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles, gathered around the Mother of the Lord (Acts chapter 2). The feast is celebrated on the 50th and final day of the Easter season.



A "strong, driving" wind filled the room where they were gathered, and tongues of fire came to rest on their heads, allowing them to speak in different languages so that they could understand each other. It was such a strange phenomenon that some people thought the Christians were just drunk - but Peter pointed out that it was only the morning, and said the phenomenon was caused by the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit also gave the apostles the other gifts and fruits necessary to fulfill the great commission - to go out and preach the Gospel to all nations. It fulfills the New Testament promise from Christ (Luke 24:46-49) that the Apostles would be "clothed with power" before they would be sent out to spread the Gospel.


VOLUNTEERS FOR GARDENING

"LET US RETURN WITH JOY!"

At the beginning of this month, the World Health Organization declared that the Covid-19 virus no longer constitutes a public health emergency of international concern. All Covid-related restrictions have been removed in our Province. For this reason, Bishop Crosby is removing the dispensation from the obligation to participate at Sunday Mass, effective on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi), June 11, 2023. Those who are impeded from participating at Sunday Mass because of ill-health, care for the sick, or some other grave reason, are not bound by the obligation to participate in the Sunday Eucharist. All the faithful of the Diocese are invited to return with joy to the Sunday Mass!
