CORPUS CHRISTI SUNDAY

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ is also known as the **Solemnity of Corpus Christi**, which translates from Latin to "Body of Christ." This feast originated in France in the mid thirteenth century and was extended to the whole Church by Pope Urban IV in 1264. At its core the solemnity is a celebration of the Tradition and belief in the Eucharist as the Real Presence of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ



We invite all parishioners to participate in the 12:30 pm bilingual Mass today (June 11th) followed by a procession to the four altars. To follow along with the procession, a booklet is available in the narthex of the church.

At the beginning of this month, the World Health Organization declared that the Covid-19 virus no longer constitutes a public health emergency of international concern. All Covid-related restrictions have been removed in our Province. For this reason, Bishop Crosby is removing the dispensation from the obligation to participate at Sunday Mass, effective today, June 11, 2023 on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). Those who are impeded from participating at Sunday Mass because of ill-health, care for the sick, or some other grave reason, are not bound by the obligation to participate in the Sunday Eucharist. All the faithful of the Diocese are invited to return with joy to the Sunday Mass!
