THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD

On February 2—forty days after Christmas—the Church celebrates the feast of the Presentation of the Lord. Mary comes to the Temple forty days after giving birth to Jesus. In addition, Mary and Joseph present and dedicate Jesus to God, as he is Mary's firstborn Son. In the Feast of the Presentation, we see that Jesus Christ is God's light to the nations, "the light of the world" (John 8:12). We see Mary and Joseph humbly obeying the Law in offering Jesus to the Father, foreshadowing the offering he himself will make on the Cross. We see that, even when we experience times of darkness in our own lives, if we persevere in fidelity to the Gospel and to God's commandments, if we allow our lives to reflect the light of Christ, then we, too, will become a light to others.

We invite you to attend Mass this coming Friday, February 2nd at 7 pm on the Presentation of the Lord. You are welcome to bring your candles for a special blessing. We will also bless the new painting of Our Lady of Czestochowa in our parish.


