THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

Forty days after Jesus' Glorious Resurrection, Our Lord ascended into Heaven (Acts 1:6-11). The Catechism of the Catholic Church (paragraph 665) says, "Christ's Ascension marks the definitive entrance of Jesus' humanity into God's heavenly domain, whence he will come again." Before ascending in the presence of His Apostles, He commissioned them to continue His ministry of redemption, saying,

Go therefore and make disciples of all nations. baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and behold, I am with you always, to the close of the age." This collection is taken up in the Easter season to support the Pope's Pastoral Services as the Head of the Church and to contribute to his works of charity.


NEW TABERNACLE
